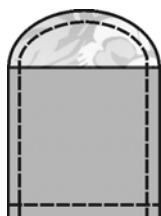


Egg warmer

Well insulated, your soft-boiled eggs will stay warm for a fair bit while you're under the shower. The lining in a contrasting colour shows at the side, since two pieces which have already been stitched together and turned are simply sewn together.

Size 14 x 10 cm



Materials

- Remnant of cotton fabric in pink, green and floral print (Amy Butler 4211, via Macheimer)
- Thin iron-on batting
- Metrosene 'Multicolor' variegated thread
- BERNINA 330, 350 or 380

Cutting out

Pink: 2 squares for the outside 10 x 10 cm. Floral fabric: 2 covers 10 cm wide and approx. 4.5 cm high, round off the corners. Green: Insides, 2 rectangles 14.5 x 10 cm, round off corners as for cover.

Instructions

Sew cover to one side of the square. Press seam allowances apart and iron on batting. With right sides facing, place insides on outsides and stitch together all round, leaving a small opening for turning. Turn, and sew opening shut. Topstitch bottom edges. Place both sections together and stitch together approx. 1 cm from the edge with the variegated thread and the triple straight stitch.
